GETTING TO VRAK – MUSEUM OF WRECKS

Public transport

Tram no. 7 to Nordiska museet/Vasamuseet. Bus no. 67 to Liljevalchs/Gröna Lund.

Boats and ferries stop near Allmänna Gränd and run yearround: Djurgårdsfärjorna ferries (from Slussen), Sjövägen 80 (from Nybroplan) and M/S Emelie (from Nybroplan, Masthamnen and Hammarby Sjöstad).

PARKING

Parking for tour buses is available at the nearby Vasa Museum.

Car parking is available on Falkenbergsgatan, at Parkering Gröna Lund. At the museum's entrance, parking is available for people with disabilities (valid permit required).

VOUCHERS

New customers who want to use vouchers as a payment method send a voucher sample to the museum for informational purposes. This must be done before the first visit with a voucher. Send the voucher sample to: info@vrak.se

For a voucher to be valid, it must contain the following information:

- $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$ The museum's name (Vrak Museum of Wrecks)
- $\boldsymbol{\cdot} \operatorname{Date} \operatorname{of} \operatorname{visit}$
- Number of visitors
- \cdot Type of service, for example admission fee
- Company registration number
- $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$ Invoicing address
- $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$ Invoice recipient's phone number and e-mail
- Contact person and phone number

Any changes you add, such as the number of visitors, should be corrected on the original voucher and signed by the group leader.

You must present the printed voucher at the ticket office when you arrive. Vrak - Museum of Wrecks charges a fee of SEK 250 per voucher if you need to print a voucher at the museum.

An invoice will be sent after your visit is completed to ensure that we bill for the correct number of visitors. Vrak – Museum of Wrecks does not attach original vouchers or voucher copies along with the invoice. We recommend that, if necessary, you create your own voucher copies.

Groups that pay the entrance fee with an approved voucher should not pre-book their arrival.

We send invoices weekly, and these include all visits during the period. Payment is due within 30 days of the invoice date. In the event of non-payment, the museum has the right to refuse visits using a voucher and instead require payment in cash.

VALUE-ADDED TAX (VAT)
